# SIGNIFICANT FINDINGS

# SIGNIFICANT FINDINGS: IMPACT

- 62% of the students have had COVID-19
- 50% of the Certificated and Classified staff have had COVID-19
- 64% of the students have missed more than 6 days of school
- 36% of the Certificated and Classified staff missed more than 6 days of work
- 66% of students never tested positive after a close contact
- 66% of students have had their social and emotional well-being somewhat or significantly affected
- 100% of the Certificated staff feel that COVID-19 absences have had a moderate or significant impact on student learning

# SIGNIFICANT FINDINGS: MASKING

- 62% of students rarely or never wear masks outside of school
- 98% of parents would feel safe sending their children to school if masks were not required
- 92% of Classified staff would feel safe working if masks were not required
- 67% of TK-3<sup>rd</sup> Certificated staff would feel safe working if masks were not required
- 100% of the 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Certificated staff would feel safe working if masks were not required

# SIGNIFICANT FINDINGS: VACCINE

- 75% of parents will **not** have their children vaccinated
- 25% of the Classified staff will **not** get vaccinated
- 100% of the Certificated staff **would** get vaccinated
- 81% of students have **not** been vaccinated and do not plan to get vaccinated
- 64% of the Classified staff **have** been vaccinated
- 88% of the Certificated staff have been vaccinated


# PARENT RESULTS

47/110 Families responded



- 32% of parents feel that their child's academic needs are being met while absent for COVID-19 reasons


1. Has your child had COVID-19? 47 responses






3. If your child missed school due to being in close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19, did they end up testing positive themselves following the close contact?


4. Has your child's COVID-19 related absences affected your work or family commitments? 47 responses



5. Has your child's COVID-19 related absences affected their social and emotional well-being? 47 responses




6. While out for COVID-19 related reasons, my child's academic needs are: 47 responses

- 87% would prefer testing over quarantining






8. School quarantine rules are well communicated.




 9. If your child has been exposed or is exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, would you be willing to have them tested in order to return to school instead of quarantining?




- 62% of students rarely or never wear masks outside of school

- 19% of parents would remove their children from school if masks were required next school year


10. Other than your home or car, do your children wear masks when they are not at school? 47 responses




11. Do you believe that masks should be required for students while indoors? 47 responses




12. If masks were not required indoors, would you feel safe sending your child to school? 47 responses




13. Have mask requirements affected your child's social and emotional well-being? 47 responses



14. Have the mask requirements affected your child's ability to learn? 47 responses




15. If California continues to require masks for all students while indoors next school year, do you plan to keep your children in public school? <sup>47</sup> responses




- 81% of students have not been vaccinated and do not plan to get vaccinated in the next 6 months

- 89% of parents do not agree with children getting vaccinated without parental consent


16. Has your child already received the COVID-19 vaccination, or do you plan to have them receive the COVID-19 vaccination in the next 6 months? 47 responses





- 33% of the Classified staff missed more than 6 days of work



2. How many days have you been home from work due to COVID-19 related reasons? 12 responses




# CLASSIFIED SURVEY RESULTS: MASKING

- 92% of Classified staff would feel safe working if masks were not required



3. Do you think that masks should be required while indoors for students and staff? 12 responses








- 64% of the Classified staff have been vaccinated

- 58% of the Classified staff are not in favor of requiring the vaccine for staff


6. Are you in favor or opposed to requiring the COVID-19 vaccination for students? 12 responses




7. Are you in favor or opposed to requiring the COVID-19 vaccination for staff? 12 responses



8. Have you already received the COVID-19 vaccination, or do you plan to receive the COVID-19 vaccination in the next 6 months? 11 responses




9. If the COVID-19 vaccination is required without a waiver for all staff do you plan to get vaccinated in order to continue in your position?



- ... I feel that vaccines should be licensed based on long-term clinical trial...


# **CERTIFICATED RESULTS**

- 100% of the Certificated staff feel that COVID-19 absences have had a moderate or significant impact on student learning



1. Have you had COVID-19? 3 responses





1. Have you had COVID-19? 5 responses





2. How many days have you been home from work due to COVID-19 related reasons? <sup>3</sup> responses







3. Do you think that masks should be required while indoors for students and staff? <sup>3 responses</sup>





3. Do you think that masks should be required while indoors for students and staff? <sup>5</sup> responses





4. If masks were optional for students and staff while indoors, would you feel safe continuing to work in your current position? <sup>3 responses</sup>







5. Have the mask requirements affected the ability to learn for your students? <sup>3 responses</sup>









- 100% of the Certificated staff would get vaccinated in order to stay in their position



9. Are you in favor or opposed to requiring the COVID-19 vaccination for students? <sup>3 responses</sup>





9. Are you in favor or opposed to requiring the COVID-19 vaccination for students? <sup>5</sup> responses





10. Are you in favor or opposed to requiring the COVID-19 vaccination for staff? 3 responses





10. Are you in favor or opposed to requiring the COVID-19 vaccination for staff? 5 responses





11. Have you already received the COVID-19 vaccination, or do you plan to receive the COVID-19 vaccination in the next 6 months? <sup>3 responses</sup>









- 60% of the 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Certificated staff would feel safe with positive asymptomatic students or staff attending school



8. If a student or staff member received a positive test but were asymptomatic, would you feel safe with them continuing to attend school? <sup>3 responses</sup>





8. If a student or staff member received a positive test but were asymptomatic, would you feel safe with them continuing to attend school? <sup>5 responses</sup>





# CERTIFICATED SURVEY RESULTS: COMMENTS

- I oppose vaccinations for younger kids because their bodies seem to be able to fight off this virus pretty well. I am aware of a couple of kids who had bad responses to the Vaccination. Older students (12 and up) I would favor it but not require it.
- Currently, I am in favor of masks, but it looks like the latest Omicron is losing its power. When it becomes less rampant, I would change my mind.
