For ELA:

- 4 [Fine Tip Expo Markers \(black\)](#) (Expo Markers will be available in the classroom if needed)
- 1 [pack of notebook paper](#) (150 sheets) (Paper will be available in class if needed)
- 1 [2 Pocket folder](#), preferably with a three-hole (If you cannot get one, Mr. Ingle has some available)
- 1 [Spiral notebook, college ruled, about 70 pages](#), with three-hole
- 1 Binder (1" Rings)
- 1 Pencil holder (cloth or plastic, hard or soft)
